

## Additional Information about the MWRTA

- All MWRTA buses have bike racks on the front of each bus
- Connects to other bus routes and communities (Hudson, Marlborough, Hopkinton, Milford, Ashland, Holliston, Southboro, Wayland, Sherborn, and Wellesley)
- MWRTA uses the Flag Down System which allows buses to stop anywhere along their routes to pick up passengers, where it is safe to do so. Passengers can hail MWRTA buses by waving.
