Route Revision & New Service

On **Monday, June 10, 2024**, MWRTA will launch revised schedules of Routes 4 North, 4 South, 7, and 11, as well as **three** new pilot summer routes.

Here is what you need to know:

Route 4 North:

- Five additional loops added to the PM schedule Monday - Friday, allowing for service every 20 minutes in the evening!
- Cloverleaf Mall (Burlington Coat/Aldi) added as a permanent stop on both AM and PM weekday and weekend schedules.

Route 4 South:

- Five additional loops added to both the AM and PM schedules.

Route 7:

- Seven additional Framingham Only loops added to both the AM and PM schedules, traveling to/from the Banana Lot to the Park & Ride.
- New York Ave added as a scheduled stop.

Route 11:

- Four express loops added to the AM, and five express loops added to the PM schedule. The express loops will have approximately a 60-minute run time, allowing for faster travel to key locations on the route.

Three Summer Pilot Routes will operate June 10, 2024 through August 30, 2024!

- **GO1** – Framingham Center (Vernon St) to Waushakum Beach. Servicing Framingham MBTA, FSU, Buckley Apts, Framingham Green, and Waushakum Beach.
- **GO2** – West Natick to Farm Pond. Servicing West Natick MBTA, Second St, Taralli Terrace, Framingham MBTA, Farm Pond, and Roosevelt Park.
- **GO3** – Natick / Wayland Loop. Servicing Golden Triangle shopping area, Beacon/Summer Sts., Framingham H.S., Saxonville Mills (Danforth St.), Saxonville Beach, Wayland Town Beach, & Cochituate State Park.

Areas of service will include: Waushakum Beach, Roosevelt Park, Farm Pond, Saxonville Beach, Wayland Beach, & more!

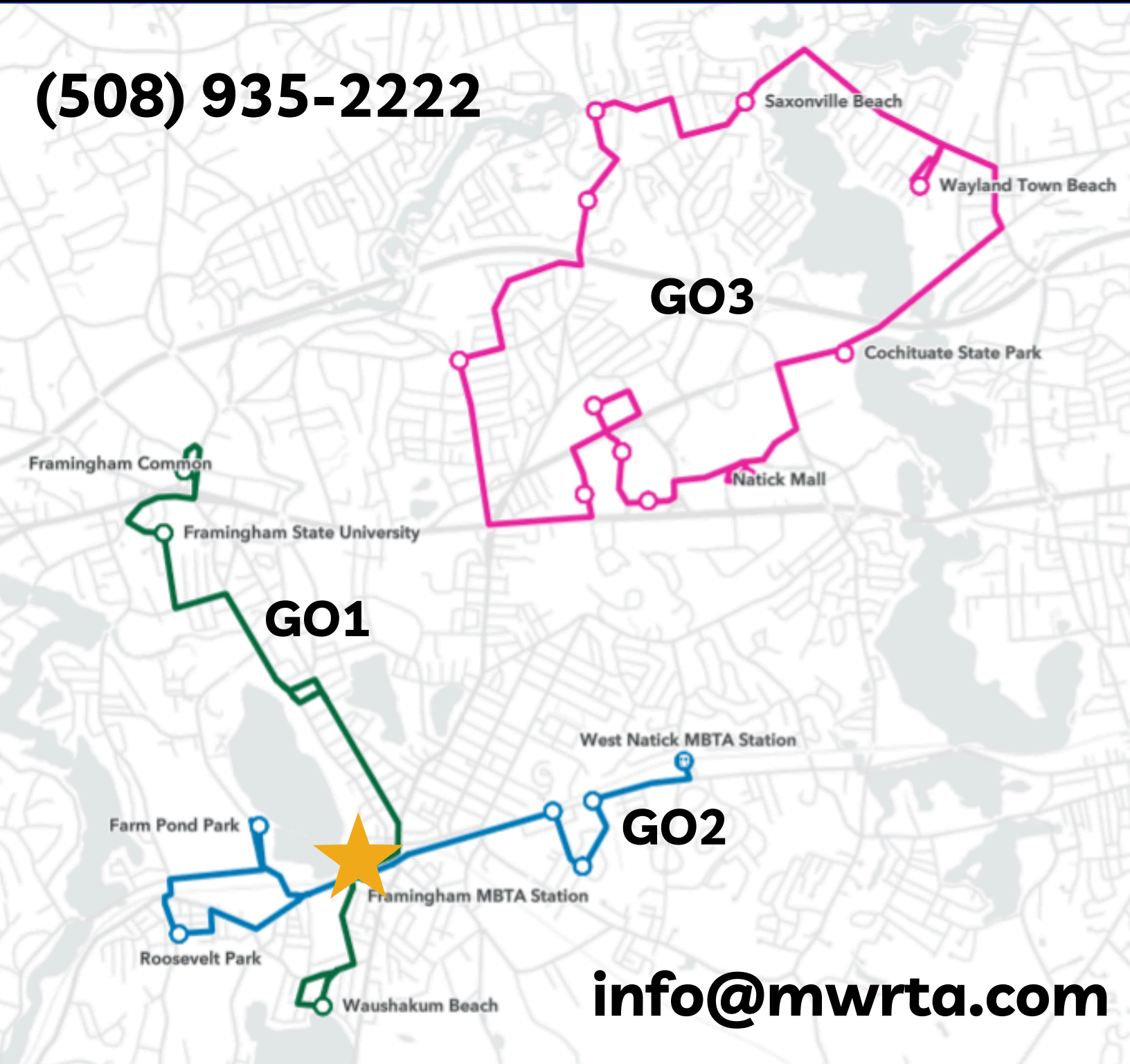
